Ruling Number: 1989-1

Date: June 1989

Constitutional Reference location (Version - September 2004, Rev. 2004.2):

Measurement Certificate 9 B “ “Measurement certificates” will be issued automatically to boats constructed by builders franchised by the designer.”

Ruling:

The Chief Measurer will develop and provide a Measurement Form to expedite the Measurement Process. It will record boats critical dimensions and provide a checklist of safety items as specified by the Constitution. The Certificate Form was initiated on 1/17/89 for the 1989 BNAC. The current Version is dated '3/04. The life of the Certificate is 5 years (expiring on 12/31/xx). Hence a Certificate issued in August of 2005 will expire 12/31/2010.

Background:

The annual BNAC Measurement process was slow and provided no records of a boats measurement. Additionally, this portion of the Constitution was not actuated by any historic and/or the current builder. The Class Measurer volunteered to accept the responsibility to develop a Measurement Form document and maintain an historical file of them.
